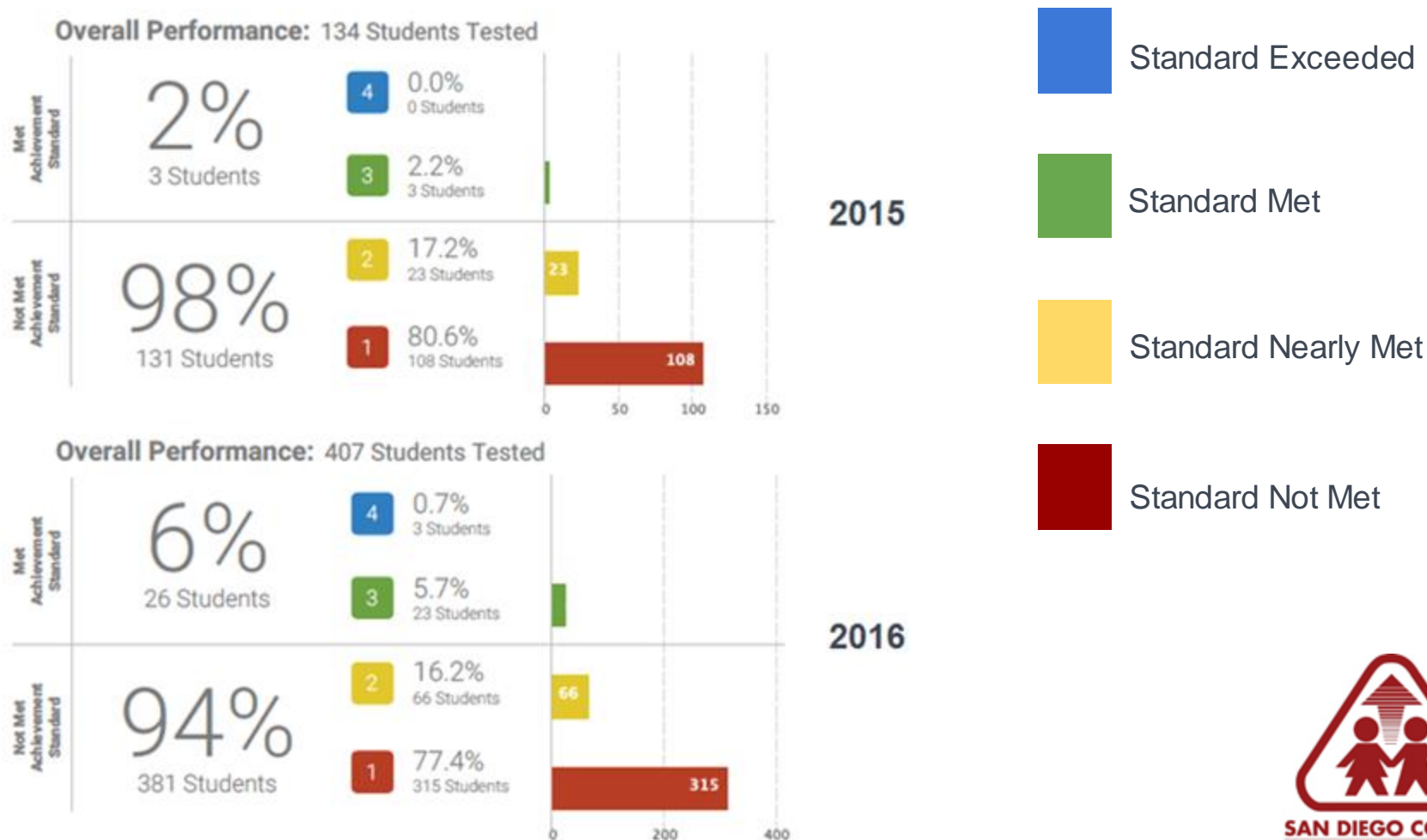

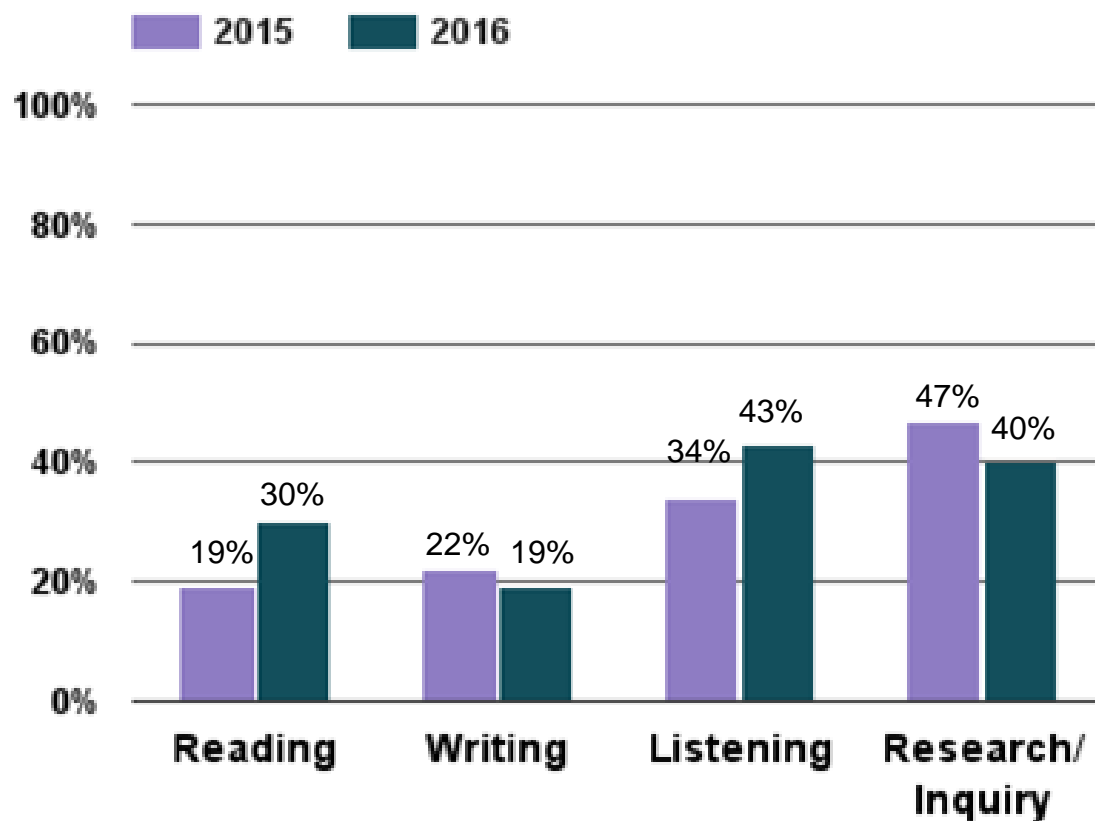

Momentum Learning student scores for overall ELA on CAASPP



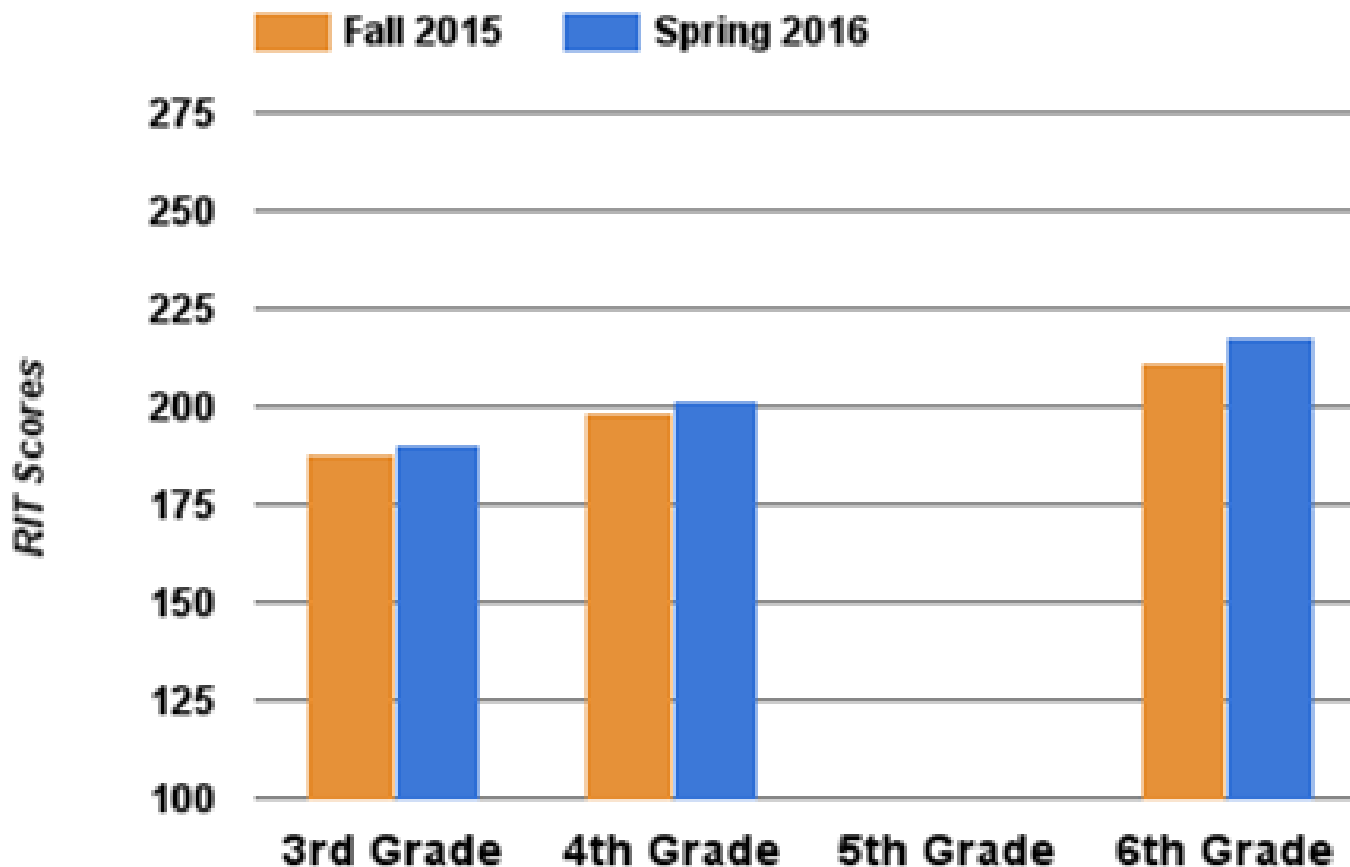

Davila Day School student scores in reading by grade on MAP

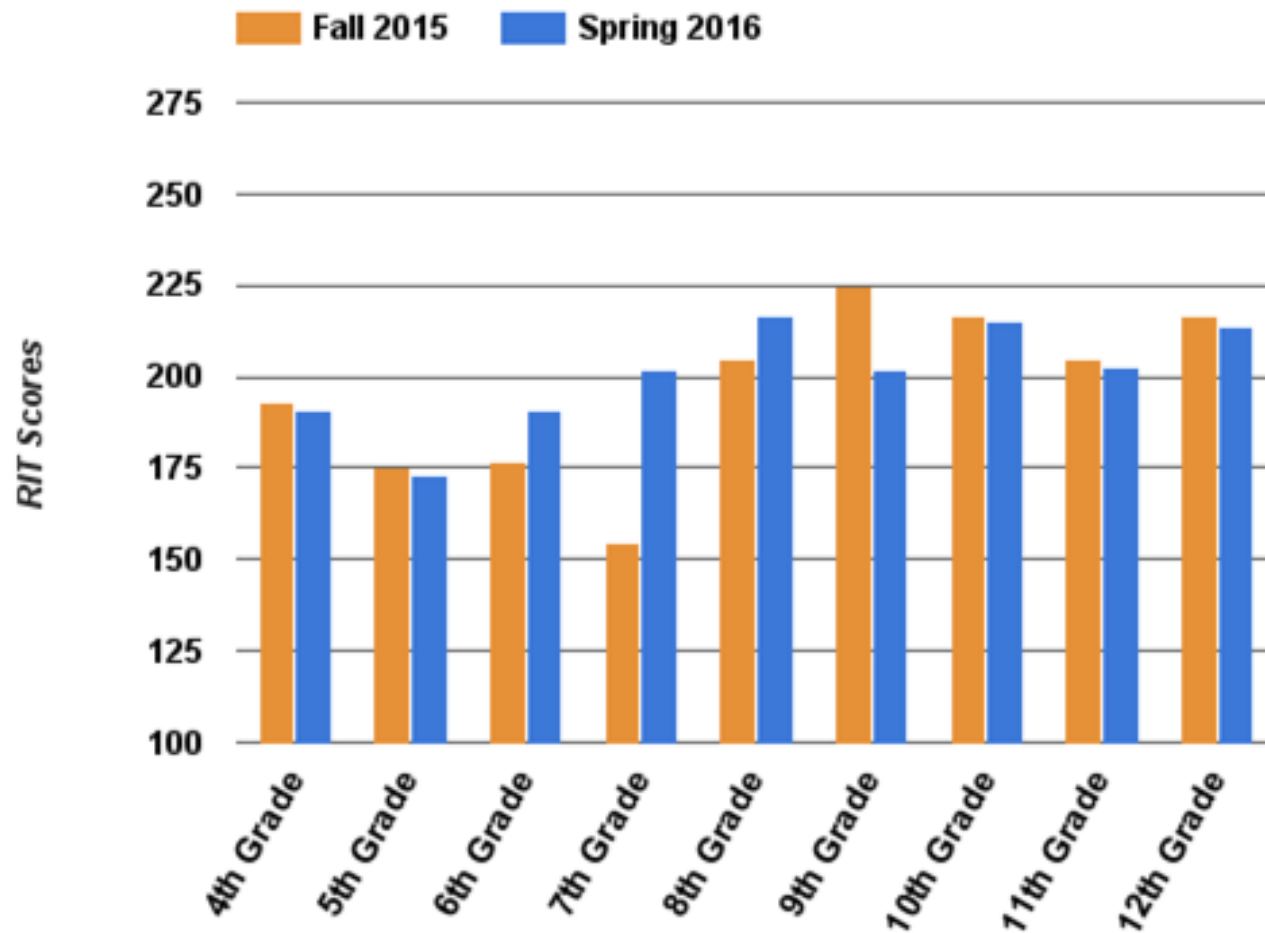

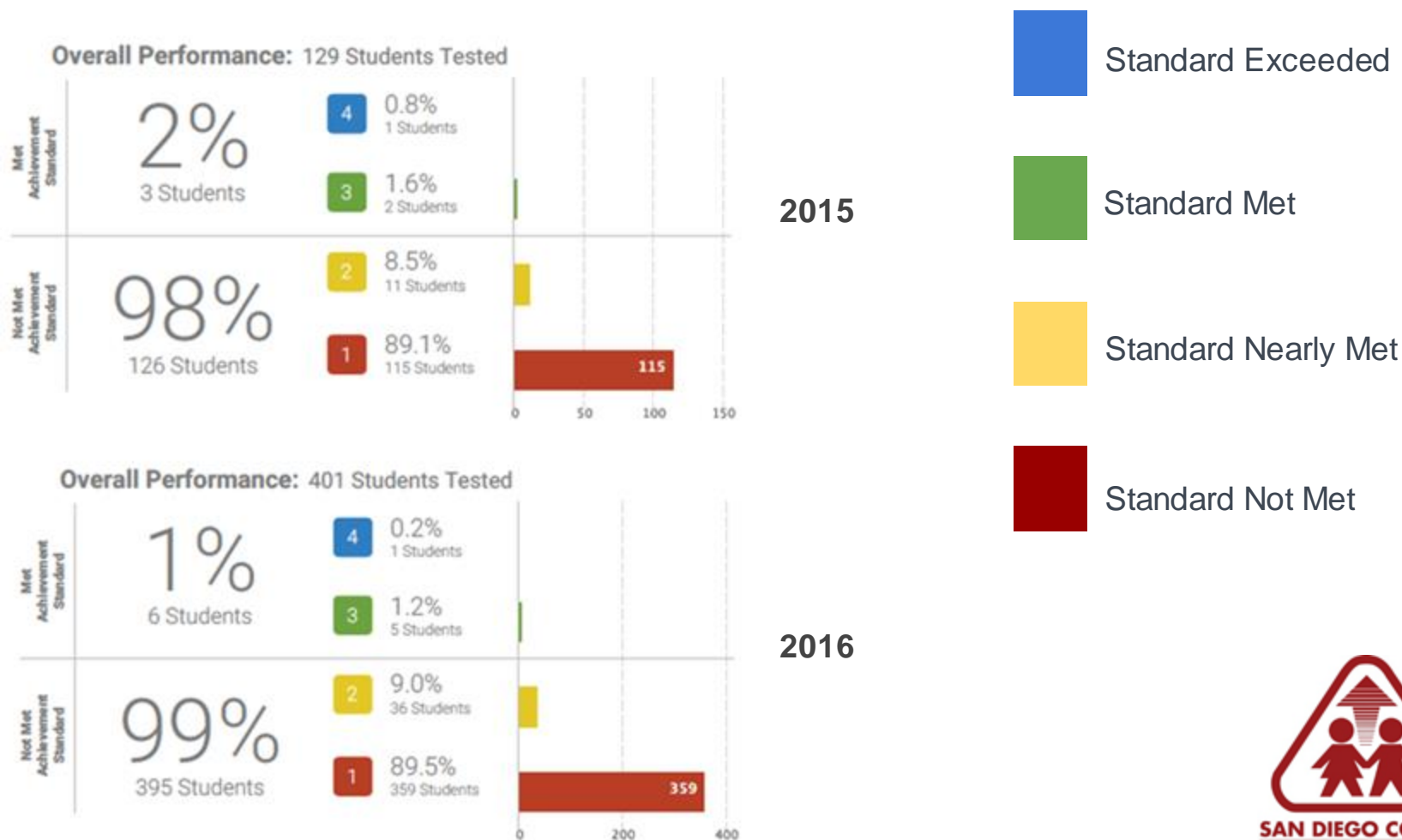

North County Academy student scores in reading by grade on MAP



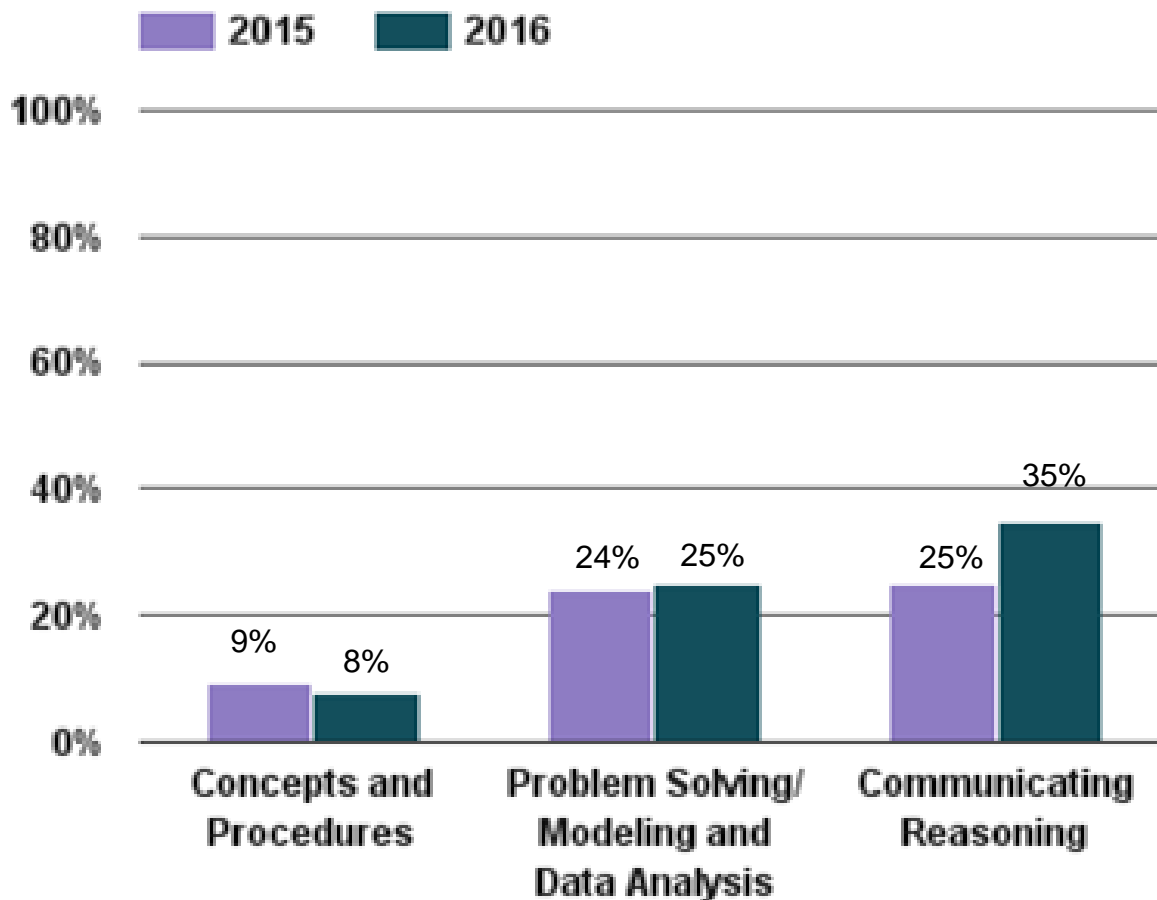

Momentum Learning student scores for overall mathematics on CAASPP



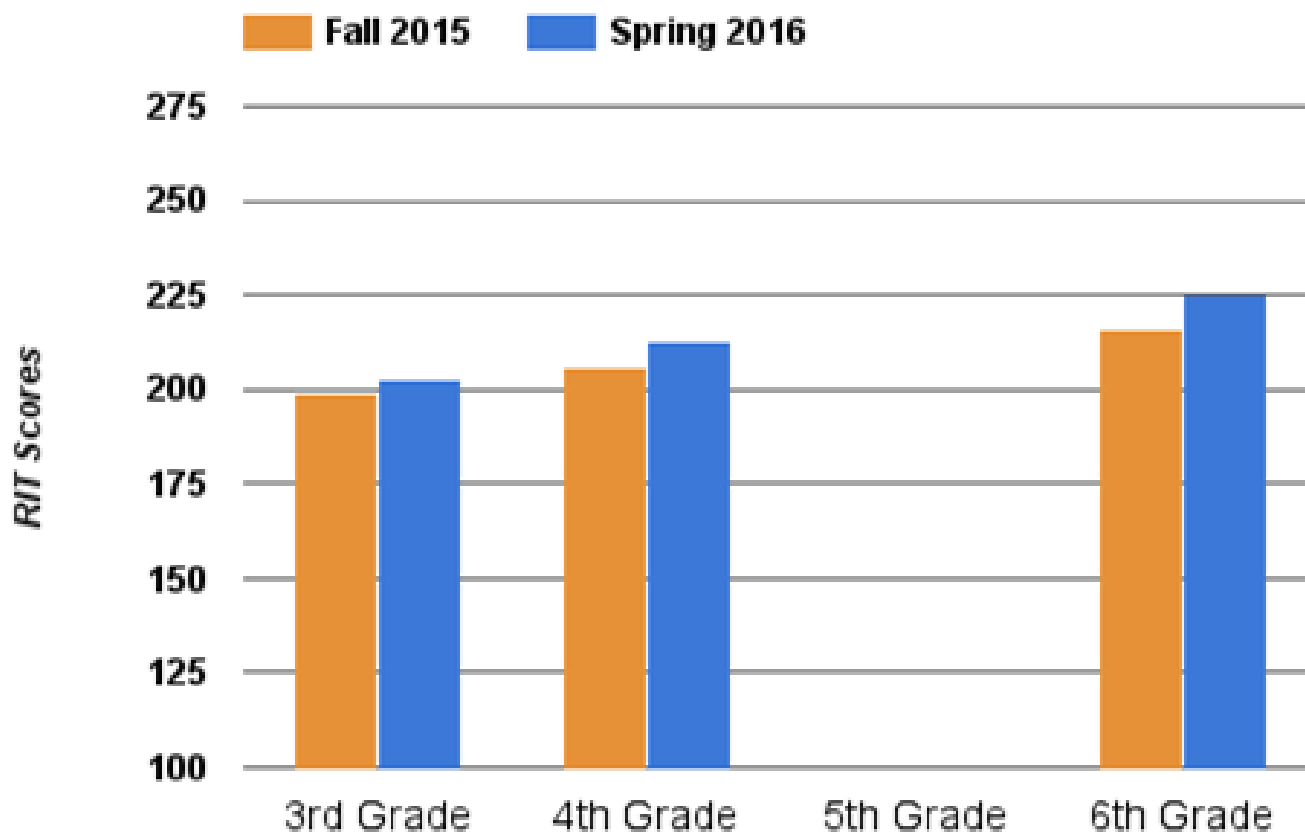

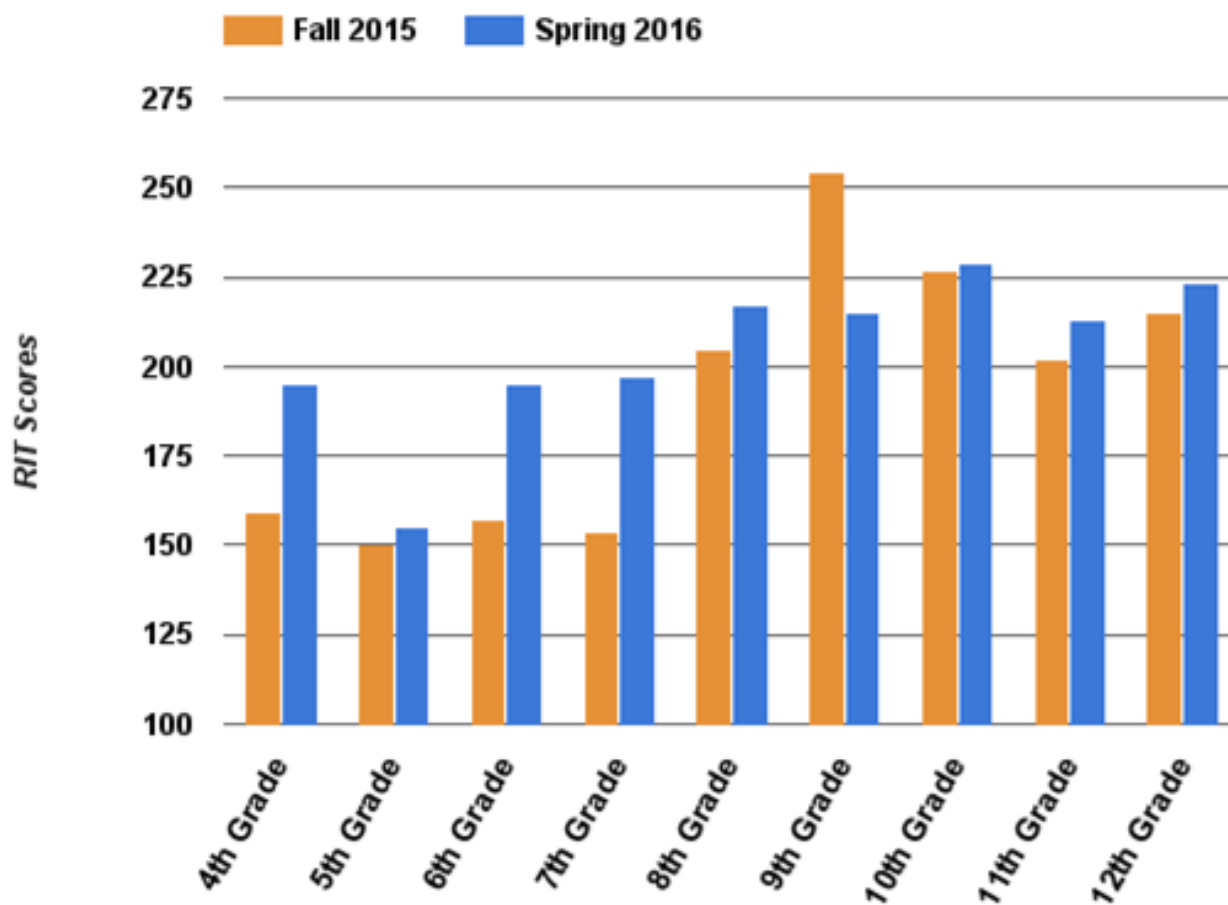
Davila Day School student scores in mathematics by grade on MAP

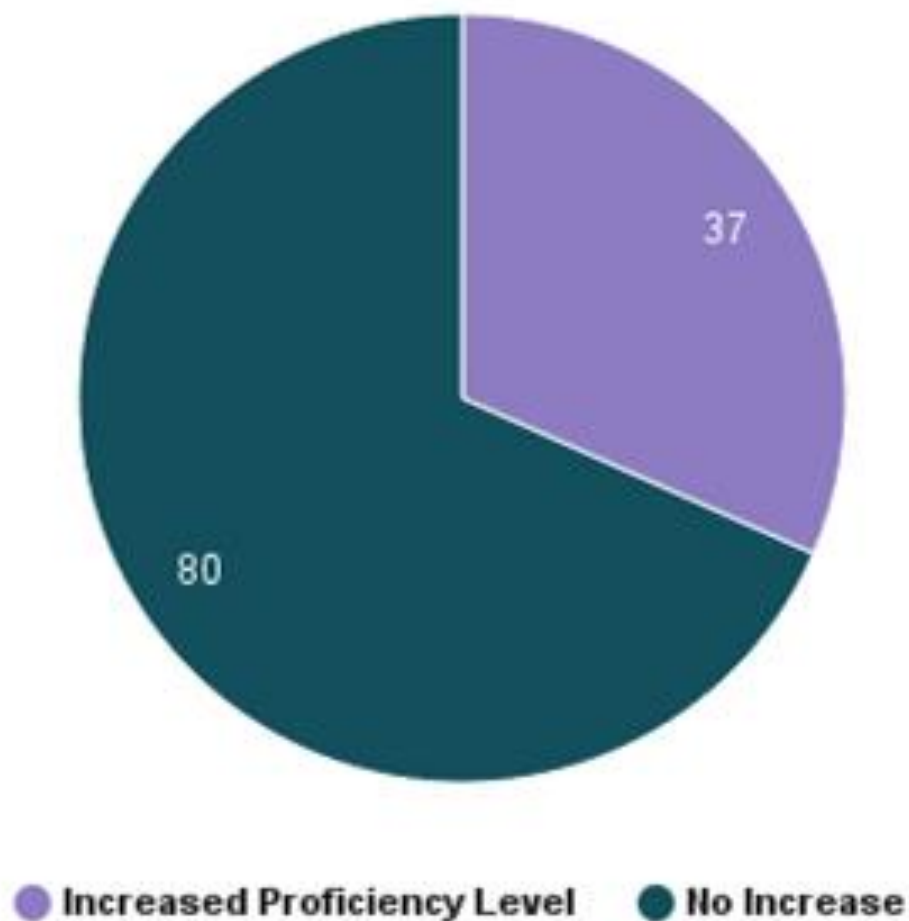

Goal 2 Next Steps

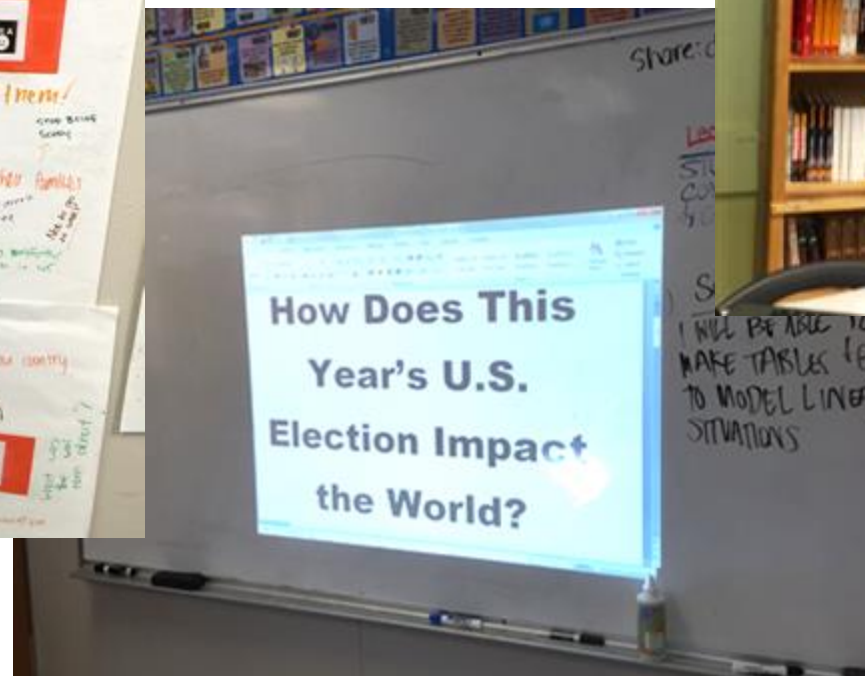
Davila Day School and North County Academy

- Continue to implement professional learning focused on MAP data and the development of rigorous and developmentally appropriate IEP goals and benchmarks
- Specific focus on engaging students in the IEP process to utilize personal performance data in IEP goals
- Continue to work with Learning and Leadership Services division to develop reading and math interventions to support our students
- Therapists and specialized staff members continue working with students on coping strategies to help with test anxiety, frustration, and perseverance through tasks that seem too difficult

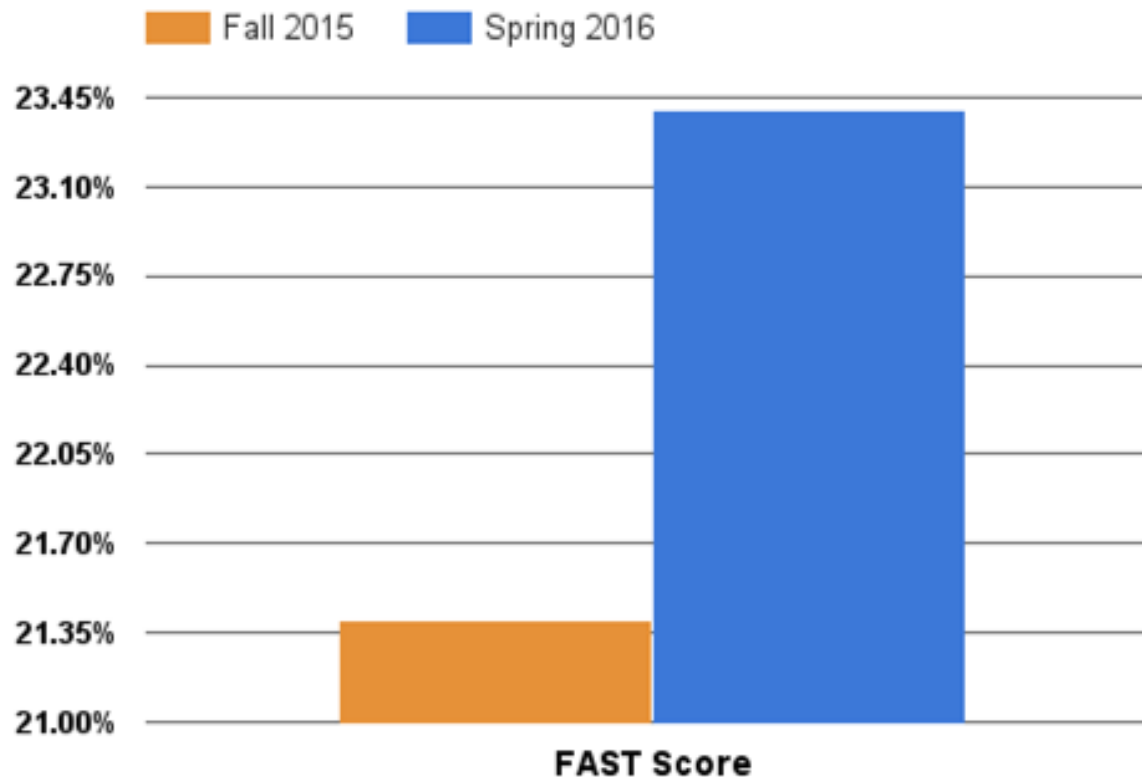

Goal 2 Progress: Alternative Assessment

Average Friendship School student scores on FAST



English Learner Students

- 11 K-12 students who are English learners at Friendship School
- Students participate in the alternate assessment for the California English Language Development Test, known as the Ventura County Comprehensive Alternative Language Proficiency Survey (VCCALPS)
- VCCALPS used to inform IEP goals
- IEP goals aligned to be linguistically appropriate
- Practice multi-modality instruction in a English mainstream classroom with Spanish supports, if needed



Next Steps

Friendship School

- Measure FAST progress from fall to spring
- Continue to focus instruction on identified California Standards
- Use companion assessment SANDI (Student Annual Needs Determination Inventory) to plan for individualized education program (IEP) goals
- Conduct professional learning opportunities and IEP goal development using assessment data and curriculum alignment
