**NEW ELECTION SYSTEM PROPOSED FOR THE BONSCALL UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Did you know?

A change in the way school board members in the Bonsall Unified School District are elected has been submitted for approval to the San Diego County Board of Education.

Why is this important?

This change would affect the way residents of the district are represented on the school district's governing board for years to come.

What is the change?

Under the new election system, the district would be divided into five geographic areas, and one board member living in each area would be elected by the voters who live in that area.

How can you get involved?

The County Board of Education is seeking input from the community on the proposed change in the district's election system and the proposed boundaries of trustee areas.

To learn about these changes and to express your opinion, you are invited to attend a public hearing conducted by the County Board of Education. Your input is welcome and strongly encouraged.
