**NEW ELECTION SYSTEM PROPOSED FOR THE RAMONA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
GOVERNING BOARD**

Did you know?

A change in the way school board members are elected has been proposed by the Ramona Unified School District Governing Board. The San Diego County Board of Education is holding a public hearing on the proposal.

Why is this important?

A change in the election system would affect the way you are represented on the school district's governing board for years to come.

What is the change?

Under the new election system, the district would be divided into five geographic areas, and one board member living in each area would be elected by the voters who live in that area.

How can you get involved?

The County Board of Education is seeking input from the community on the proposed change in the district's election system and the proposal boundaries of trustee area.

To learn about these changes and to express your opinion, you are invited to attend a public hearing conducted by the County Board of Education. Your input is welcome and strongly encouraged.
