

**GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED TRANSFERS OF UNINHABITED TERRITORY**

NOTE: Until further notice, consistent with Executive Order N-29-20 from Gov. Newsom, the San Diego County Board of Education meetings, including public hearings, will be conducted via a virtual environment using Zoom. To submit a public comment for the upcoming public hearing, please copy the following URL link into the browser address bar: <https://www.sdcoe.net/public-comment> (the link is active once the agenda is published).

The recording secretary will tape-record the entire meeting.

1. The order of speakers will be as follows:
 - Spokesperson(s) for the district/petitioner
 - Public comments read in the order submitted
2. The designated spokesperson(s) for the school district shall have 10 minutes for an initial presentation.
3. In order to be read into the record during the meeting, a public comment must be submitted prior to the start of the public hearing through <https://www.sdcoe.net/public-comment>. It will be read into the record with a maximum allowance of 3 minutes per individual comment (approximately 390 words), subject to the Board Secretary's discretion. Only one public comment can be submitted by each member of the public. The President of the County Board of Education, acting as the County Committee on School District Organization, may reduce the time allotted to each public comment based upon the number of public comments received.
4. When all timely submitted public comments on the proposal have been read, the President shall declare the public hearing closed.
5. The County Committee on School District Organization shall approve or disapprove the petition for the transfers of territory at a subsequent meeting after completion of the reorganization process.
