YOU WILL THEREFORE TAKE NOTICE that this matter will come before the Board of Education, San Diego County, acting as the County Committee on School District Organization, on Tuesday, January 26, 2021, at 5 p.m. for the Vista Unified School District and 6 p.m. for the San Marcos Unified School District.

Newsom, the San Diego County Board of Education meetings, including public hearings held by the County Committee on School District Organization, will be conducted via a virtual environment using Zoom.
