**SUBJECT: Possession, Consumption, and Sale
of Alcoholic Beverages at Outdoor
School Sites Used as Retreat Facilities**

The County Board of Education owns facilities at which a residential instructional program, operated by the County Superintendent of Schools and known as the Outdoor School Program, is provided to students from San Diego County school districts. When not in use for the Outdoor School Program, these facilities may be used as retreat facilities for other legitimate and lawful activities. Such use by other programs, groups, or individuals generates additional revenue to support the operation of the Outdoor School Program.

Business and Professions Code section 25608 permits the possession, consumption, and sale of alcoholic beverages, pursuant to a license, permit, or authorization obtained under the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, for an event held at an overnight retreat facility operated by the County Superintendent of Schools at times when students are not on the grounds.

The County Board of Education directs the County Superintendent of Schools or designee to ensure that procedures for the possession, consumption, and sale of alcohol at Outdoor School sites used as retreat facilities provide for strict compliance with law.
