LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY

As elected officials, the County Board of Education recognizes a commitment to maintain a program of legislative representation involving educational issues at the state and federal levels. The County Board of Education also recognizes the need to take a position on appropriate local and statewide ballot issues.

SPONSORED/COSPONSORED LEGISLATION

The County Board of Education recognizes a commitment to sponsor legislative proposals to meet the needs of students and to improve the quality of public education in the State of California. The County Board of Education shall review and approve legislative proposals recommended for sponsorship by the County Superintendent of Schools, or cosponsored with school and community college districts and other organizations.

The County Superintendent of Schools shall develop an administrative regulation to implement this policy.
