The County Superintendent of Schools establishes the following guidelines to implement Board Policy 1160, Legislative Activities.

LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY

1. A Legislative Task Force shall analyze and take positions on legislative bills and issues. The County Superintendent of Schools shall appoint employees to serve on the Legislative Task Force.
2. The County Superintendent of Schools may designate a primary spokesperson on behalf of the County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools on issues of legislative advocacy.
3. The County Superintendent of Schools or his/her employees may present testimony to members, committees, and staffs of the Legislature, the Congress, and local, regional, or state governmental decision-making bodies. All contacts shall be coordinated with the County Board/County Office's legislative representative in advance and specific authorization obtained from each employee's assistant superintendent.

SPONSORED/COSPONSORED LEGISLATION

1. The Legislative Task Force is designated to develop and recommend legislative proposals for sponsorship by the County Board of Education.
2. The County Superintendent of Schools shall coordinate the preparation and submission of legislative proposals for San Diego County Office of Education sponsorship to the County Board of Education for review and approval.
