The County Superintendent of Schools encourages visits to the schools and programs operated by the County Superintendent of Schools by parents/guardians, members of the community, and other interested persons in order to view the education program and facilities and to offer constructive comments.

Parents, community members, and other interested persons may attend school programs such as open house occasions, special program events, and observe classroom activities.

Classroom visits shall take place in a manner which causes minimal disruption to the instructional program and ensures the preservation of a safe and suitable learning environment. In all cases, responsible adult behavior shall be required of all visitors.

Unauthorized visitors who pose a threat to the health and safety of students, teachers, or other personnel or who otherwise disrupt the normal operations of the school shall be removed.

Possession of unauthorized dangerous instruments, weapons, or devices is prohibited on school premises or any other place where a teacher or a student are required to be in connection with assigned school activities.

This administrative regulation is subordinate to applicable policies and procedures of school districts, community colleges, training institutions, Probation Department, or other agencies having legal jurisdiction over the student.
