The County Superintendent of Schools encourages the preparation of quality written materials for publication by the County Superintendent of Schools and San Diego County Office of Education. The principal author(s) of those publications will be given public recognition for their contribution to printed materials in accordance with this administrative regulation.

Individual principal authors, consultants or employees, of major San Diego County Office of Education publications may be identified as authors, according to customary publishing format, on the title page of the work they have written. All attributions of authorship will be determined by the division assistant superintendent at the time preliminary approval is given to develop the material. Other acknowledgements will be included as appropriate, according to customary publishing format. Proprietary rights to all publications by the County Superintendent of Schools shall remain with the County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools whether or not such material is copyrighted.
