SUBJECT: Grades/Evaluation of Student Achievement PAGE: 1 of 1

The County Superintendent of Schools believes that students and parents/guardians have the right to receive course grades that represent an accurate evaluation of the student's achievement. Teachers shall evaluate a student's work in relation to grade-level standards which apply to all students and, not in relation to the work of other students in one particular class.

Grades should be based on impartial, consistent observation of the quality of the student's work and his/her mastery of instructional objectives and course content.

It is the responsibility of the program administrator to ensure that all student grades/credits are recorded on an official transcript issued by the County Superintendent of Schools.

Annual reviews for special education students in schools and programs operated by the County Superintendent of Schools must be held according to federal and state Education Code regulations.
