SUBJECT: Expulsion, Right of Appeal

If a pupil is expelled from school, the pupil, if of the age of majority, or the pupil's parent/guardian may appeal the school district's expulsion to the County Board of Education in accordance with Board Policy No. 5144.

In order to ensure a fair and impartial review, the County Superintendent of Schools shall provide:

1. The relevant Education Code sections outlining the County Board of Education's scope of review in expulsion appeal hearings along with the *Notice of Filing of Expulsion Appeal* to the pupil or the pupil's parent/guardian and the expelling school board.
2. Correspondence in both English and the primary language of the pupil or the pupil's parent or guardian.
3. A translator proficient in the primary language of the pupil or pupil's parent/guardian at the County Board of Education appeal hearing.
4. Transcripts of the County Board of Education appeal hearing in English and the primary language of the pupil or the pupil's parent/guardian if requested. The requester shall pay the cost of providing the transcripts.
