A role of the County Superintendent of Schools is to provide instructional support to the administrators, teachers, and students in San Diego County. To accomplish this goal, the San Diego County Office of Education:

- ! Functions as an intermediate unit between local schools districts and the California Department of Education.
- ! Provides curriculum development and instructional improvement services needed at all levels, especially for small school districts.
- ! Provides a comprehensive professional development program for administrative and instructional staff focused on the improvement of student achievement through trainings in all curricular content areas.

The San Diego County Office of Education operates specialized schools and programs which are legally authorized to be operated by the County Superintendent of Schools.

To meet these instructional responsibilities, the County Superintendent of Schools:

- ! Administers the education programs of the San Diego County Office of Education.
- ! Determines the curriculum consistent with state law and County Board of Education Policies to meet the needs of students.
- ! Selects and organizes a highly qualified certificated and classified staff to provide leadership in implementing curriculum and instructional programs that are consistent with state directives, County Board of Education Policies, and the adopted mission and goals of the San Diego County Office of Education.
- ! Approves the purchase of instructional materials and equipment for the schools and programs.
