SUBJECT: School-Sponsored Trips

School-sponsored trips are important components of a student's development. Program administrators and/or school principals shall ensure that school-sponsored trips comply with the following procedures:

1. Plans for school-sponsored trips are pre-approved by the program administrator.
2. Plans for school-sponsored trips provide for the safety of students and their proper supervision by certificated staff. Other employees of the County Superintendent of Schools and parents/guardians may also participate in the supervision and may be asked to attend preparatory training sessions and/or meetings.
3. Students shall have written parental/guardian permission in order to participate in school-sponsored trips. An alternative educational experience shall be provided for students whose parents/guardians do not wish them to participate in a school-sponsored trip.
