Prior to entering upon the duties of their office, all members of the County Board of Education shall take the oath or affirmation required by law.

The oath may be administered and certified by any County Board member, the secretary or assistant secretary to the County Board, the County Superintendent of Schools, the Superintendent of Public Instruction, or any other person authorized in Education Code section 60 or Government Code section 1225.

The executed oath shall be filed with the County Clerk.
