The County Board of Education (Board) has the power to establish its own procedures of governance within the parameters of law.

Bylaws are the rules governing the internal operations of the County Board of Education. When need for a new bylaw or modification of an existing bylaw is recognized, the County Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee will be directed to develop a proposed bylaw for consideration by the County Board.

Proposed bylaws and suggested amendments to or revisions of existing bylaws may be adopted by a majority vote of all members of the County Board. The same procedure for the adoption of policy shall be followed for adoption of County Board Bylaws.
