The County Superintendent of Schools shall establish and maintain an orderly plan for preserving and making accessible the policies and bylaws adopted by the County Board of Education and the administrative regulations. The policies, bylaws, and administrative regulations shall be published and made available electronically in a manual, maintained in current condition, and accessible on the San Diego County Office of Education Web site.

POLICIES

Policies are statements of intent that are adopted by the County Board of Education. They serve as guides to the administration in the development and implementation of regulations for operating the San Diego County Office of Education.

Formulation, adoption, and amendment of Board policies shall be in accordance with Board Bylaw 9311.

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

The County Superintendent of Schools develops and adopts administrative regulations as necessary or convenient to the discharge of his/her official duties. Administrative regulations to support the policies adopted by the County Board of Education shall be specified in the respective County Board of Education policy and conform to state and federal laws and regulations.
