SUBJECT: Fund-Raising Activities

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Fund-raising activities sponsored by the County Superintendent of Schools and/or the County Board of Education shall be only for programs and activities that are consistent with the mission of the San Diego County Office of Education.

With the approval of the County Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee, San Diego County Office of Education schools and programs or related organizations may organize fund-raising events involving students and/or employees. Fund-raising materials shall not be distributed unless approved by the County Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee.

Student and/or employee participation in an authorized fund-raising activity is on a voluntary basis. No student or employee shall be made to feel uncomfortable or pressured to participate or provide funds. No student or employee shall be barred from an activity because he/she did not participate in the fund-raising event.

The County Superintendent of Schools shall maintain an administrative regulation to implement this policy.
