SUBJECT: Concept and Role of Classified Personnel

The primary role of classified personnel is to assist the County Superintendent of Schools in complying with the statutory requirements and authorized functions of his/her office and in achieving the mission and goals of the San Diego County Office of Education.

The classified service shall consist of all employees in positions not requiring certification qualifications. The following positions shall not be considered a part of the classified service:

1. Positions which require certification qualifications.
2. Full-time students employed part time.
3. Part-time students employed part time in any college work-study program, or in a work experience education program conducted by a community college district and which is financed by state or federal funds.
4. Apprentice positions.
6. Positions established for the employment of professional experts on a temporary basis for a specific project by the County Superintendent of Schools or by the Personnel Commission when so designated by the Personnel Commission.
