The County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools believe that work experience education programs can provide students with valuable instruction in the skills, attitudes, and understandings they need in order to be successfully employed.

The County Superintendent of Schools shall not refer students to employers for work experience education without the employer's assurance of compliance with nondiscrimination laws.

The County Superintendent of Schools shall develop and implement a Work Experience Education Plan in the areas of vocational, general, and exploratory work experience.

The County Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee shall periodically review the Work Experience Education Plan to ensure compliance with state and federal laws and California Department of Education regulations.
