The County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools recognize that physical and mental abuse of children, including neglect, sexual assault, and sexual exploitation, have severe consequences for children.

The County Superintendent of Schools shall maintain an administrative regulation that implements child abuse reporting procedures under legal mandates.
