SUBJECT: Safety

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The County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools place a high priority on safety and on the prevention of student injury or accident. Administrators, principals and staff are responsible for conduct and safety of students from the time they come under San Diego County Office of Education supervision until they leave that supervision, whether on school premises or not.

Every reasonable precaution shall be taken for the safety of students in programs and schools operated by the County Superintendent of Schools not only as a protective measure during school hours, but also as an instructional means of developing appropriate student behavior to minimize accidents at all times.

The County Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee shall establish an administrative regulation to protect students from dangerous situations.
