**SUBJECT: Concepts and Roles**

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The County Board of Education recognizes that the San Diego County Office of Education provides leadership, coordination and support to the schools and programs operated by the County Superintendent of Schools and to local school districts through curriculum development and instructional improvement.

The County Board of Education:

- ! Articulates the educational philosophy and goals through policy which reinforces the adopted mission and goals of the San Diego County Office of Education.
- ! Directs the County Superintendent of Schools to work with instructional staff in the development and implementation of curriculum and effective instructional strategies to meet the needs of students and staffs in schools and programs operated by the County Superintendent of Schools.
- ! Provides resources and facilities for an on-going program of professional development for staff guided by realistic and continuously reevaluated San Diego County Office of Education mission and goals.
- ! Expects the County Superintendent of Schools to report on the attainment of the adopted goals of the San Diego County Office of Education in the area of instruction.
