It is the intent of the County Board of Education that independent study be available to students in all schools and programs operated by the County Superintendent of Schools.

It is further the intent of the County Board of Education that independent study provide students with the opportunity to fulfill regular classroom requirements through an optional alternative instructional strategy outside of the classroom based on the individual needs of the participating student.

The County Superintendent of Schools shall maintain an administrative regulation that ensures compliance of independent study with the requirements of state laws and regulations.
