- ♥ **Romantic eCards** – If you receive an email with a supposed Valentine's Day greeting, it could be malware, so don't click on links that come from unknown sources.
- ♥ **Phishing for your passwords** – Don't be swooned by people you don't know and never, ever give out your login details over the Internet!
