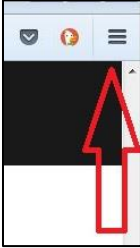


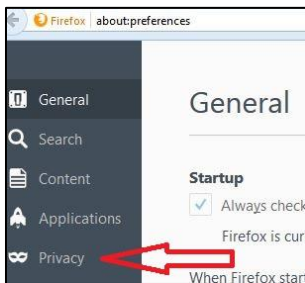
How to Clear Cookies Using Firefox, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome and Safari

FIREFOX

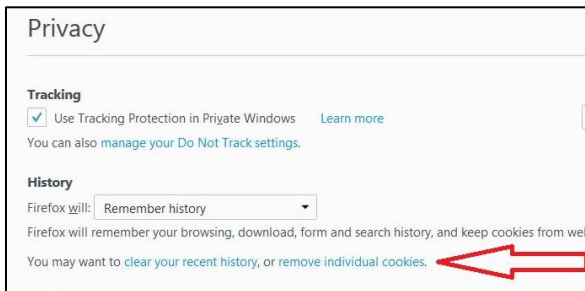
1. Click the **Open Menu** icon (the three horizontal lines, or 'hamburger') in the upper right corner of your screen, and then choose **Options** (the gear icon):



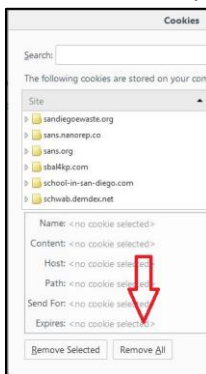
2. Within the **Options** menu, select **Privacy** from the menu on the left side:



3. On the **Privacy** tab, select **remove individual cookies**:



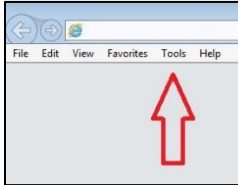
4. On the **Cookies** page, click **Remove All**



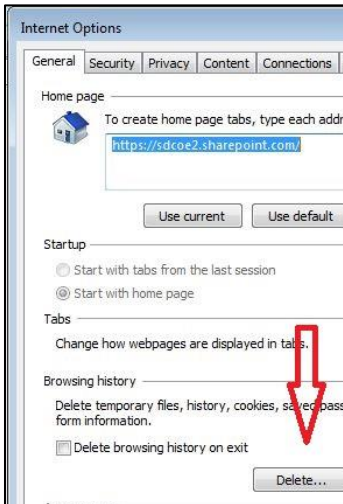

INTERNET EXPLORER

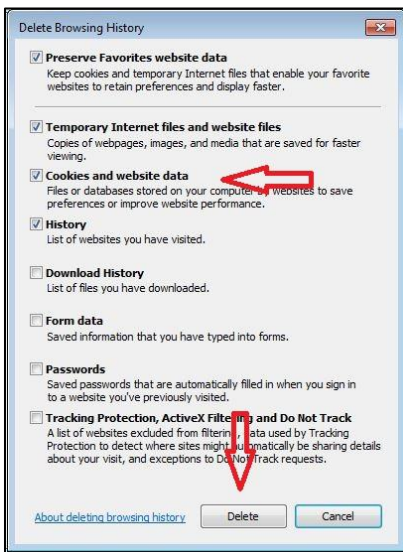
1. Click on **Tools**, and when the menu comes up, select **Internet Options**:



2. On the **General** tab, in the **Browsing history** section, click the **Delete** button:



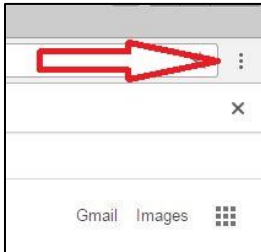
3. On the **Delete Browsing History** window, make sure the check box for cookies and website data is selected, and then click the **Delete** button:



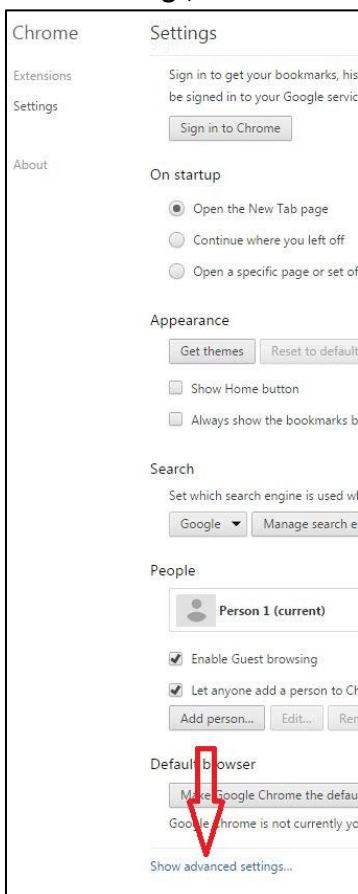

GOOGLE CHROME

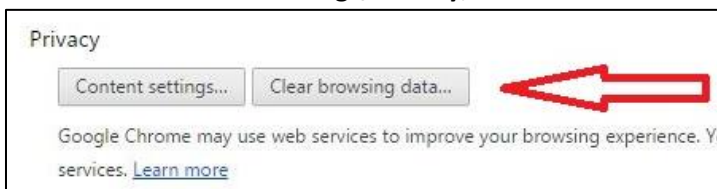
1. Click on the **three vertical dots** on the right side of the address bar and then click **Settings**:



2. Within **Settings**, click on the link at the bottom for **Show advanced settings**:

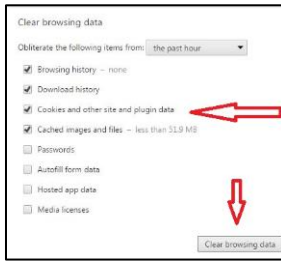


3. Within the **Advanced Settings/Privacy**, click the box for **Clear browsing data**:

4. Ensure the check box for **Cookies and other site and plugin data** is selected, and then click the **Clear browsing data** button:

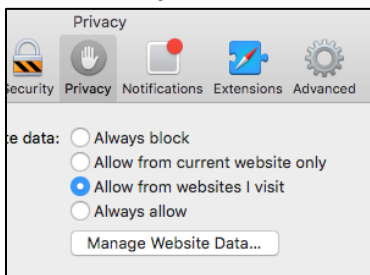


SAFARI

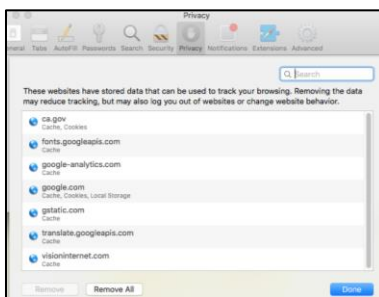
1. Select **preferences** from **Safari** menu



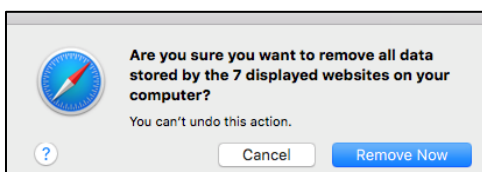
2. Select **Privacy** and click on **Manage Website Data**
