Music Therapy building upon skills identified/targeted by classroom staff and the speech therapist, utilizing a multi-sensory and motivation based approach, it is provided by a certified Music Therapist.

Qualifications of the Provider Delivering "Other Related Service"

The Music Therapy Services are provided through a CDE approved Nonpublic Agency and have the necessary certifications/trainings required to meet the qualifications.
