## Considerations as Schools Reopen

### Anxiety



Student, staff and parent anxiety is a major concern. The increased trauma, grief, social stressors and uncertainties of reopening schools are causing high levels of anxiety. Considerations need to be taken in to account that a balance between academics and mental wellness be made.

### Connectivity



Students have lost social connectivity, and for many engagement and motivation in school have suffered. Time, resources and intentional actions need to be spent on building relationships and fostering engaging school climates.

### Support



The growing mental health needs, lack of support and stigma associated with receiving services were all stated concerns. All youth mental health serving agencies and organization need to work together to streamline referral processes and meet the needs of students mental health.

## Enhancing Suicide Prevention Efforts

### Prevention

- Need for increased district wide communication and coordination of training efforts
- Offer information, training and resources for parents
- Consistent distribution of resources, toolkits, and curriculum throughout year

### Intervention

- Protocols and practices in place for student assessments ensuring comprehensive care that includes parents
- Evidence based risk assessment tool that is universally shared and used across all districts and schools

### Postvention

- This was identified as the largest area of growth for districts
- Increase understanding and planning around best practices
- Increase awareness and usage of toolkits, templates and checklists
