Reorganization Elections

The County Superintendent of Schools shall order elections to reorganize school or community college districts as required by action of the County Committee on School District Organization, the California State Board of Education, or the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges. The election shall be held on an established election date, and the cost of the election shall be a charge against the County School Service Fund in San Diego County.

The area of election may be determined in accordance with applicable Education Code provisions by the type of reorganization proposed, approved plans and recommendations for the reorganization, court decisions on area of interest, or action of the county committee, State Board of Education, or Board of Governors.

A majority vote is required to authorize district reorganization. When voters approve a reorganization, the Board of Supervisors makes the order to reestablish boundaries. Action is complete on the date of the Board of Supervisors' action. The reorganization is effective for all purposes on July 1 of the calendar year following the calendar year in which the action is complete.
