There are four types of grants available:

Grant #1: Music Technology

Grant Range: Up to \$3,000

Valid uses of funds: Purchase of technology programs or hardware to support the use of music technology in the classroom. Examples of appropriate expenditures: computers, music keyboards, music software.

Grant #2: Teacher Professional Development

Grant Range: Up to \$300

Valid use of funds: Training workshops/classes for educators desiring to grow in their knowledge of music. The workshop must apply to content knowledge that will enhance instruction in the classroom setting. Examples of appropriate expenditures: County CMEA Conference, classes at local universities or colleges.

Grant #3: Field Trip to Musical Events, Media Facilities or Music Museums

Grant Range: Up to \$500

Valid use of funds: Class/student field trips to music-centered radio stations, museums, concerts. Examples of appropriate expenditures: Trip to local media facilities, the Museum of Making Music, music industries events, the symphony. *This grant will not provide or supplement funds used to transport students to their own performances.

Grant #4 Innovative

Grant Range: Up to \$ 1,000

Valid use of funds: This grant is for educators that have always wanted to do something innovative to enhance the music education of their students. The sky's the limit. The funds must be used to facilitate the music education of the students and not for the professional development of the teacher.
