1. List three major activities and accomplishments during the contract reporting period.

[1] First 5 San Diego funded a study of local child care needs conducted by USD School of Leadership and Education Science for the Child Care Subsidy Pilot Plan. [2] The CTKS program achieved highest level of participation, exhausting allotted 17/18 funds prior to June 30. [3] The zip code priority report was successfully completed using a new CDE template, as part of the annual needs assessment process.

2. Identify problems and proposed resolutions to local planning issues and activities.

The council has focused staff time to include operational tasks according to bylaws and reporting requirements. With limited funding, staff has not been able to address all goals stated within terms and conditions of the contract, which do not require direct reporting.

3. Coordination/Collaboration Efforts (California First 5, CalSAFE, Native American Indian Tribes, etc.).

The council is in collaboration with many community partners; such as Community Care Licensing, First 5 San Diego, San Diego County Office of Education, County of San Diego, YMCA Childcare Resource Services (R&R), and Quality Preschool Initiative (local QRIS). The council also coordinates county-wide EESD contractor meetings and events.
