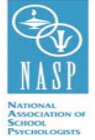

CRISIS INTERVENTION AND RECOVERY: THE ROLES OF SCHOOL-BASED MENTAL HEALTH

NASP, APA, NBCC – Approved

This two-day workshop is designed to provide school-based mental health professionals with the knowledge, and to begin to develop the skills, needed to meet the immediate needs of students and staff following a school-associated crisis. The PREP_aRE model suggests that, as members of a school crisis team, school-based mental health professionals must be involved in the following hierarchical and sequential set of activities. First, the mental health professional strives to prevent those psychological traumas that can be avoided and prepares for those that cannot. Second, once a crisis event has occurred, school-based mental health professionals initially focus on helping to reaffirm physical health and student perceptions that they are safe. Third, school-based mental health professionals evaluate the degree to which individuals have suffered psychological trauma. Fourth, based upon evaluation data, school-based mental health professionals provide and respond to the psychological needs of school community members. Finally, the effectiveness of school crisis intervention and recovery efforts is examined.
