This all-day interactive workshop will take participants through the entire suspension and expulsion process. Topics will include, but are not limited to, the suspension process and limitations, investigative steps (including search and seizure, use of surveillance cameras, and involvement of law enforcement), the expulsion process and limitations, considerations for students in special populations, challenges and appeals, and the maintenance and transfer of discipline records.

Participants will be able to work through real case scenarios to check for understanding and proper application of the laws, policies, court decisions, and best practices that guide the suspension and expulsion process. Participants will also receive the most current edition of the Student Discipline in California Schools publication and a USB flash drive with resources, reports, and sample forms and letters.
